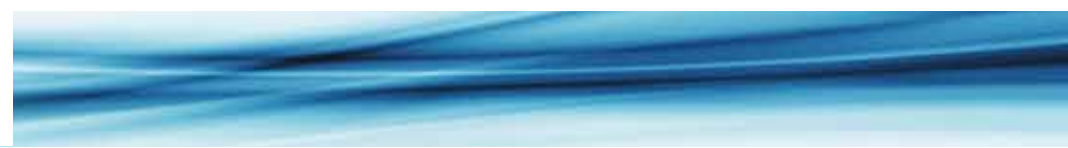

Progress Award

Company showing consistent improvement over three years in days away from work (DAFW) & total recordable incident rate (TRIR)

Recognition Award

Company with DAFW & TRIR lower than the national industry average and three years improving EMR or < .9

Achievement Award

Company with DAFW & TRIR lower than NWI industry average and EMR < .9 and demonstrate an acceptable safety management system

Excellence Award

Company must meet Achievement Award criteria and have an EMR lower than the NWI industry average

Innovation Award

Company that has played a proactive role at a Member Company site in developing a new safety initiative

Contractor of the Year Award

Company who first meets the Excellence Award criteria; selected by Member Companies based on application evaluation and overall contributions to the safety culture in Northwest Indiana as a whole

The Roger Walters Memorial Award

The award will be presented to the safety representative that has demonstrated extraordinary contributions to the safety of the workers in Northwest Indiana.

We are not looking for a single great act but a person whose everyday diligence and dedication to their field creates a working environment that mirrors the slogan "Never Give Safety A Day Off".

Roger Walters took safety seriously. It was not just a job to him, it was his life. He felt responsible for those who worked under his care and helped out other safety representatives by correcting situations at their site or letting them know of problems. I am sure that there are people out there who owe their lives to him, because they had him looking out for their well being and safety.

He spoke up, even when in difficult situations, because he couldn't just "let it go". It was just not in his constitution to walk away with an unresolved situation. He was always honest and truthful and fair. He always took the time to talk things over and earned the respect of all those who worked with him over the years.

He was always looking out for everyone. He was the one you could always count on to know the answer or who could direct you to the right source. And, he didn't stop with safety at work, he lived it every day, at home, when out with his family, on vacation, and really in everything he did. Just listening to his stories made it real, he made you feel like you were there, and that you too could have the dedication and courage to do the things he took for granted. He was a selfless champion and a hero and he will be missed.

The candidate must have:

- At least 3 years experience and at least 50% of their job must be dedicated to safety
- Worked 3 years for a company located in Northwest Indiana
